

# Feline Vaccination Protocols

Many of the national veterinary organizations (American Veterinary Medical Association, American Animal Hospital Association, American Association of Feline Practitioners, etc) are recommending using a 3 year vaccination protocol instead of the traditional yearly vaccines. A number of studies from various sources indicate many animals (especially cats) benefit from receiving 3 year vaccines instead of yearly vaccines (fewer side effects and complications). We offer 3 year rabies and distemper vaccines. Some vaccinations are still needed on a yearly basis to fully protect your pet.

Our clinic offers both a 1 year vaccination protocol and 3 year vaccination protocol.
